25 washing cycles at 60°C
(according to ISO 6330 6N).

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

- Fixed taffeta lining for greater wearing comfort.
- Fully seam sealed for optimal protection from foul weather.
- Detachable elastic straps, adjustable by plastic buckles and hook and loop loops for better hold.
- Knees reinforced with comfort darts and system at bottom of reinforcement to evacuate water.
- Comfort triangle at crotch.
- Two hand openings with two hook and loop fastenings and one snap fastening.
- Comfort gusset at bottom of each leg with three hook and loop fastenings.
- Back protector.
- One RETHIOTEX® 30 100 microbeads retroreflective strip of 8 cm, sewn on.
- One grey REFLEXITE® GP 340 microprismatic retroreflective strip of 5 cm strip, sewn on.



RAW MATERIALS

OUTER FABRIC

- Wovetex Strong waterproof-breathable 2-layer laminate 100% polyester fabric. Weight: 200 g/sqm.

LINING

- 100% polyester taffeta lining.

RETROREFLECTIVE FABRIC

- RETHIOTEX® 30 100 microbeads retroreflective fabric. Industrial washing compatible. 70 washing cycles at 60°C (according to ISO 6330 6N).
- REFLEXITE® GP 340 grey microprismatic retroreflective strip. 75 washing cycles at 60°C (according to ISO 6330 6N).

STORAGE

The NEPAL rain trousers are packaged in individual transparent packaging.

The product must be stored in its original packaging in a cool, dry place away from light.

CARE

Wash at 60°C.

25 washing cycles are authorised (according to ISO 6330 6N).

Do not bleach, iron, dry clean or tumble dry.
